

YEMHI MEMORIAL COLLEGE EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

I. OBJECTIVE:

The educational sector is becoming expensive with each passing year and many promising students belonging to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) of the society are unable to pursue higher education due to lack of financial support. Keeping this view in mind, the Yemhi Educational Scholarship has been introduced to provide financial assistance to meritorious students from EWS of the society irrespective of caste, creed or gender.

II. ELIGIBILITY:

- a) The scholarship is open to all nationals of India
- b) Students securing 60% & above in NBSE and 80% & above in CBSE are eligible to apply
- c) Scholarships will be paid to the students whose parents/guardians' annual income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2 Lakhs.
- d) A scholarship holder under this scheme can also apply for Post Matric Scholarship Schemes sponsored by the Central/State Governments as Yemhi Educational Scholarship is purely an independent sponsored scheme.
- e) Students who had pursued their Higher Secondary studies (10 + 2) through correspondence courses are not eligible to apply.

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III. VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- a) The value of Scholarship will be Rs. 18,000/- for 3 (Three) Years Under-Graduate courses covering 6(Six) Semesters.
- b) The Scholarship amount will be paid in installment basis at the rate of Rs. 3000/- per semester which can be encashed or adjusted at the time of each semester admission.

IV. CRITERIA:

- a) The Scholarship is dependent on the satisfactory progress & conduct of the student. If it is reported by the Head of the Institution/Teachers/Mentor at any time that a student has by reasons of his/her own act of default failed to make satisfactory progress or has been guilty of misconduct, irregularity of attendance without the permission of the authorities concerned etc, the institution sanctioning the scholarship may either cancel the scholarship or stop or withhold further payment for such period as it may think fit.
- b) If a student is unable to appear in any of the exams conducted by the institution/ University owing to illness or on account of any other unforeseen events, the decision for renewing the scholarship will be decided upon by the Scholarship Committee in coordination with the College Management.
- c) If a student is found to have obtained the scholarship by providing false statements, his/her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid will be recovered. The student(s) concerned will be blacklisted and debarred for scholarship in any scheme for ever.
- d) The minimum qualifying marks for eligibility and the amount of the scholarship awarded will be revised from time to time.
- e) A student receiving scholarship from the institution should complete his/her course of study from this college. Any student desiring to leave the institution at the middle of the academic session, he/she should repay back the amount received as scholarship to the institution. Failing to comply with the decision will result in non issuance of Transfer Certificate.

V. PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:

An application for Scholarship should comprise:

- a) One copy of the application for scholarship in the prescribed form (Separate application forms as have been prescribed for ‘Fresh’ and ‘Renewal’ Scholarship by the concerned authority)
- b) One copy of the passport size photograph with signatures of student thereon.
- c) One attested copy of certificates, in respect of all examinations passed.
- d) An income declaration by the self-employed parents/guardians, stating definite income from all sources by way of an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper. Employed parents/guardians are required to obtain income certificate from their employer and for any additional income from other sources, they would furnish declaration by way of an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper.
- e) Application complete in all respects should be submitted to the Scholarship Committee.

VI. SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE:

- a) Scholarship Committee shall be constituted by the Principal in consultation with the Chairman, Managing Board, Yemhi Memorial College.
 - b) The Committee shall consist of 3 (Three) members from among the faculties.
 - c) The Committee shall scrutinize the applications received and shall put up to the Principal to ascertain who fulfills the eligibility criteria.
 - d) The duration of the Scholarship Committee shall be for a period of 3 (Three) years.
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
